



David "Dave" Granat


August 14, 1954 - June 19, 2021

a Memorial Service will be held at a date and time to be announced. Flowers declined.



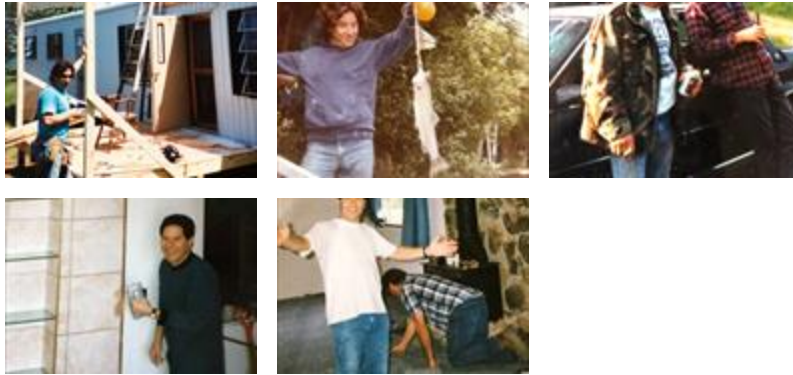

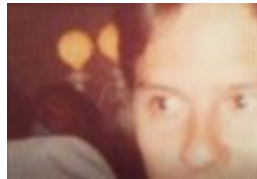
