Lendel – Edward C. Jr. 86 of Venice, Florida, former resident of North Tonawanda passed away on July 12, 2020. Edward was born in Buffalo, New York on June 11, 1934 to Edward C. Lendel, Sr. and Agnes (Hess) Lendel. Edward was a proud serviceman for over 40 years in the Air National Guard which included time served in the Korean Conflict and the Vietnam War. He retired as a Senior Master Sergeant working as a supervisor in data processing at Niagara Falls Air Force Base. Edward officiated softball, baseball, basketball and soccer for the Western New York Umpire Association for over 40 years. After his retirement, Edward was employed as a starter at Deerwood Golf Course. He embraced many community organizations: Epiphany Cathedral Catholic Church, longtime member of St. Joseph Catholic Church, Eucharistic Minister at both churches to include serving the homebound, the American Legion, Sikora Post, St. Joseph's Holy Name Society, and blood donor for the American Red Cross.
