James was a United States Army Veteran who served from 1953-1955, graduate of Valparaiso University in 1958 as a Civil Engineer, a member of St. Paul Lutheran Church for 55 years, worked for Krehbiel Consulting Engineers from 1958-1974, received his professional Engineering license in 1967, worked for the Town of Grand Island for 21 years from 1974 until he retired in 1995, began as the town Engineer, then as the Superintendent of the Wastewater Treatment Plant. Upon his retirement he continued to enjoy hockey, golf, bowling, camping, traveling, and spending time with grandchildren. James was predeceased by his brother Joseph and his sister Ida Mae Johnson.
