JOHN D. "JACK" SLATTERY of North Tonawanda, age 79, passed away Thursday December 9, 2010 in DeGraff Memorial Hospital.

Mr. Slattery served in the United States Army Signal Corps during the Korean War following his graduation from Ft. Monmouth Electronic School.
