Joseph M. Black, 72, of North Tonawanda, surrounded by his loving family, passed away on August 11, 2024 after a brief illness. He was the son of the late Thomas and Mary (Sparks) Black. Survived by his beloved wife of 51 years, Christine (Sarzyniak). Devoted father of Jeffrey (Meghan) and Daniel (Summer), grandpa of Jaret, Meredith and Derek, and “furbaby” Libby.
