When my dad passed away, Lacie was the first person to drop off food to my family. My sister said “she walked in like she owned the place- she had such confidence and was so beautiful”

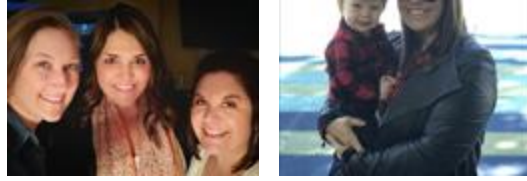
She invited my last minute to a concert, I was at work and didn't have “going out” clothes or even make up on... she went to Target and bought me an outfit and brought her make up for me to use!

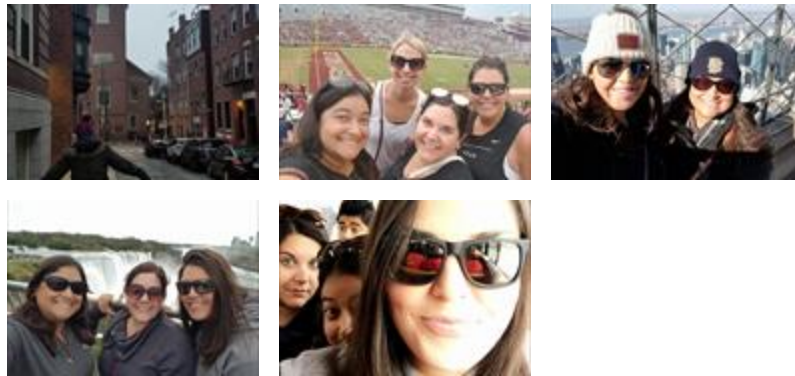
