Patrick Thomas Kelley, 77, surrounded by his loving family, passed away on July 25, 2024. He was the son of the late Clifford and Dorothy Kelley. Patrick married Noreen Carole Hummell in 1968, beginning their journey of love and creating a beautiful family. Devoted father of Christine Bingham, Patrick Jr. (Carolyn), and Laura (Robert) Wagner. Papa of Sara and Emily Bingham. Dear brother of Maureen (late John) Jumper, brother-in-law of late Gerald (Carolyn) Hummell and Phillip Hummell. Uncle of Jack (Kathryn) Jumper and Christopher Jordan Hummell. Great uncle of Liam, Brendan and Mary Kate Jumper. A graduate of St. Joseph's Collegiate Institute, Patrick enlisted in the United States Marine Corps after high school serving as a combat engineer in Vietnam until his honorable discharge. For his bravery to his country, Lance Corporal Kelley received the Purple Heart Medal, National Defense Service Medal, Vietnam Service Medal, and Vietnam Campaign Medal. After his service to the United States, Patrick earned his college degree from Niagara County Community College and entered the workforce. After a dedicated career, including 18 years at Gold Bond company, he retired from Invensys Corporation after 22 years. Patrick will always be remembered for his genuineness, and his legacy is one of patience, selflessness, and dedication to his family.. His involvement extended to his community as an active member of the American Legion Post 264 Tonawanda for 56 years and Rescue Fire Company #5 spanning six decades where he held numerous positions including President.
