



## Paul A. Thielke

August 14, 1943 - March 19, 2009

Paul A. Thielke, age 65, of St. Louis, Missouri, passed away March 19, 2009. Paul was born August 14, 1943 in North Tonawanda, son of the late Norman Thielke and Lucille Knoell Thielke.

Paul received his Bachelor of Arts degree in Economics from Ohio University in Athens, OH in 1965. He held numerous positions in state and federal government agencies as well as private firms such as Tektronix and Honeywell, specializing in job classifications, pay grades, and salary surveys in Chicago, IL, Columbus, OH, and Beaverton, OR. He also worked as an independent management consultant and compensation analyst for many years in the Washington, DC area, lastly at Washington Hospital Center. Shortly after starting there, he developed epilepsy, preventing him from active employment.

Although Paul never married, he lived with his brother Alan for many years in various cities and later with his mother in Gaithersburg, Maryland. There he became active in service to Calvary Lutheran Church as an elder and comptroller. In addition to being a detailed record keeper, he enjoyed tinkering

with sports cars and was an avid reader who loved to debate the areas of his many interests: politics, economics, history, government, current events, biblical history, archeology, and the family genealogy.

He is survived by his siblings Alan, Elaine (and Bob) Steinbach, Phyllis (and Dan) Richter, Laura, and Ann (and Mark) Richter. He is also survived by his nieces Rebecca (Steinbach) Slaby, Kate Steinbach, Liz Richter, Toni Richter, and Typhanie (Coller) Richter, and by his nephews Josh Richter, Peter Richter, Colin Slaby and Steve Richter. He is also survived by his grand-niece Emma Slaby.
