Raymond P. Krantz of North Tonawanda, passed away unexpectedly, December 14, 2014 at DeGraff Memorial Hospital at the age of 73.

Mr. Krantz was born July 30, 1941 in North Tonawanda, son of that late Ronald and Catherine (nee Leslie) Krantz.

Raymond attended local school and served in the United States Army. He served on the North Tonawanda Paid Fire Department from 1966 until his retirement in 2000, he retired as Captain of Fire Prevention.

Mr. Krantz volunteered at DeGraff Memorial Hospital and DeGraff Adult Daycare a total of 2,223 volunteer hours.

He was a member of St. Paul Lutheran Church in North Tonawanda where he served as an usher, a greeter and was on the fire safety committee, he had also been an elder, an usher, member of fire safety committee and choir member at St. Matthew's Lutheran Church.

Mr. Krantz was a member of Sweeney Hose Co. #7 ,and a member of the North Tonawanda Volunteer Fireman's Benevolent Association.

his children and his beloved grandchildren. He loved his two dogs Bell and Fella.
