Richard Joseph Wrazin, born January 2, 1942, passed away peacefully on April 27, 2026, surrounded by the love of his family and friends. Above all, Richard lived life to the fullest. He worked hard and played hard, showed up for everything, and most of all, loved deeply. To his family, he seemed almost invincible—someone who would do anything for the people he loved. He faced a long journey with Lewy body dementia with remarkable strength, determination, and grace, never losing his spirit or his connection to those around him. He cherished time spent with family and friends, especially during annual family vacations to Hilton Head, where countless memories were made. He will be remembered for his warmth, generosity, competitive spirit, and the joy he brought to those around him. He leaves behind a lasting legacy of love, friendship, and community.

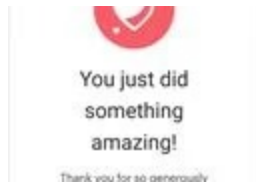
