William Francis Rosenthal succumbed to cancer on December 7, 2013, at the age of 76. The

son of Joseph Morton Rosenthal and Bessie Alice Keefe-Rosenthal of Glens Falls, NY, he is

survived by his wife of 53 years, Olga Marie Fote-Rosenthal of East Amherst, NY, two

daughters, Alice Barber (Fred) of North Tonawanda, NY and Teresa Eick (Norman) of Nassau,

NY, Grandchildren, Tamara Eick, Daniel Eick, Frederick Barber and many cousins.

Bill was born in Glens Falls, played football and graduated from Glens Falls High School in 1956.

In October 2007, he and his team mates were inducted into the G.F.H.S Athletic Hall of

Fame. He was very proud of this honor. He graduated in 1960 from the University of Buffalo,

where he met his wife, and in 1967 from SUNY Albany, where he earned his Master's in Social

Work. He was employed by New York State Department of Social Services until his retirement

in 1994.

He was a veteran who served his country in the US Army after college and was stationed in Fort

Belvoir, VA where he rotated to special duty in Greenland.

After retirement, Bill wintered in Arizona and eventually moved there full time. He returned to

NY this fall for treatment at Roswell Park Cancer Institute and to be near his daughters.
